## This funding will be used to

- Develop and implement an evidence-based and consistent whole school Australian Curriculum approach, to upskill staff across the school and continue to build consistency of moderation with our local cluster.
- Continue to embed a consistent intervention and extension Fountus and Pinnel reading program across the whole school. To increase the number of students reaching National Minimum standard to 50% in Years Three and Five.
- Continue to embed an intervention phonics program, Read Write Inc from Prep –Two and throughout the school where needed. To increase the amount of students in the upper two bands to 40%.

## Our initiatives include

- Employing specialist teachers to build the capacity of the Australian curriculum and teacher capability.
- Continuing to build the profile of the school with the community through school readiness programs.
- Employing a HOC and Intervention Teacher to quality assure, plan, and embed the Australian curriculum across the school. To dissect and build data capacity with teachers across the school.

Enabling teachers to attend professional development, collaborative data conversations and cluster moderation.	\$7,000
Employing skilled Teacher Aides to support student learning through finite reading blocks, reading intervention and extension programs and an intensive phonics program.	\$31,000
Continuing to build a strong reading program through the employment of an intervention teacher, the employment of a HOC (Head of Curriculum) to embed consistency of curriculum and big picture strategic planning.	\$33,718
Embedding the Australian Curriculum with the employment of specialist teachers.	\$5,000
Supporting community engagement that promotes a diverse and inclusive culture that supports transitions and wellbeing.	\$3,000
